# CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

### Scholarships for international students enrolled in Bachelor's and Master's programmes

The Foundation for the University of Sopron awards scholarships on a competitive basis with the aim of supporting the studies of international students enrolled in a Bachelor's or Master's programme at the university.

#### **Eligibility:**

International students enrolled in Bachelor's or Master's programmes are eligible to apply for the scholarship on a semesterly basis, starting from the third semester of their studies for Bachelor's programmes and from the second semester of their studies for Master's programmes.

#### **The amount of financial aid:**

Scholarship amount: 50,000 HUF per person per month (5 months of funding per semester).

#### **Eligibility requirements for the scholarship:**

- Active student status in a full-time Bachelor's or Master's programme;
- A weighted GPA of at least 4.0 in the last active semester preceding the semester for which the scholarship is being applied;
- Earning a minimum of 55 credits in the two semesters preceding the submission of the scholarship application for Bachelor's programmes; earning a minimum of 25 credits in the semester preceding the submission of the application for Master's programmes;
- Engagement in academic, outstanding creative arts, or athletic activities;
- Outstanding student community involvement is considered an advantage during the evaluation of the application.

Applications must be submitted via the Neptun academic system (application code: SOE\_12\_03)

Application deadline: **April 26 (Sunday), 2026, 11:59 p.m.**

Documents to be attached to the application:

- Document(s) supporting academic achievement or outstanding creative or athletic activities
- Certificate of outstanding student community involvement (optional)

Attachments must be submitted with the application in **PDF** format only.

In the event of an incomplete application, the Office of the Vice Rector for Education will send a single request to remedy the deficiencies via email; the deadline for remedying the deficiencies is 5 business days from the date the notification is sent. The date the notification is sent does not count toward the

deadline. Failure to meet the deadline results in disqualification; the evaluation committee will not consider late or incomplete applications.

Bodies involved in the evaluation of the application:

- Committee on Educational Development (advisory)
- Board of Trustees of the Foundation for the University of Sopron (decision-making)

The committee is expected to make a decision on scholarship applications by May 16, 2026. Applicants will be notified of the decision via the Neptun academic system. A maximum of 20 students university-wide are expected to be awarded the scholarship

If a student's enrollment status is terminated or suspended during the period in which the scholarship is being paid, the scholarship may no longer be paid to the student, and the student is required to repay any scholarship funds already received.
